Assignment 1:

READ Ghost Boys by Jewell Parker Rhodes.

REFLECT on the following question:

"Both the novel and short story deal with the concept of being haunted by loved ones, bearing witness to the hard truths of the past, and trying to listen to the lessons of the dead. How do you think the last lines of the short story ("When your soul aches, speak to the dead/Ancestors who loved you, still do...they're always listening/if you let yourself hear, they will guide you.") reflect these themes and issues in the novel (*Ghost Boys*)?

WRITE a four to five paragraph essay based on the reflection question. Use examples from both the texts to support your ideas.

Essays will be due on the first day of school and will help guide our discussion on the novel.

Assignment 2:

READ any book of your choice.

POST a one minute book review video to our <u>summer reading recommendation Padlet.</u>
Be sure to include the name of the book/author, genre, a spoiler-free plot synopsis, other books it reminds you of ("If you liked Mr. Oden's School of Wizard Children Not Called Harry Potter, you'll love..."), and why you enjoyed reading it!
